Food waste is an important issue for all local authorities. Under the National Waste Prevention Programme (NWPP), the Local Authority Prevention network (LAPN) is offering free training on Food Waste Surveys and Food Waste prevention.

One or two people from your region are welcome to join this course. The course will be delivered by the Clean Technology Centre, CIT. CTC has carried out dozens of food waste surveys in hotels, restaurants, canteens, and hospitals, and has developed a comprehensive methodology.

Why attend?

Helping businesses identify ways to reduce direct business costs through reduced waste, energy and water consumption and other behavioural changes is an important service to the business sector.

Who should attend?

Staff of all local authorities are welcome. The course is primarily aimed at Environmental Awareness Officers, but may be of interest to other staff.

Project Work

Applicants will be expected to commit to undertaking a project involving 2-3 businesses in their region.

Equipment required to undertake this work can be provided.

Other Courses

It is intended to run similar courses on water use reduction, and greening of festivals in the coming months.

These will also be free of charge.
